Jayme reflected upon his time here, saying “We are thankful because we need to come here to improve ourselves. We don’t have this kind of training back home in Brazil, and we appreciate that we can study and grow to be a better professional.” Ely shared his comrade’s sentiments by explaining that the “key part [of Northeast Maritime Institute] is the total support you guys gave to us.
