



OPERATOR OF UNINSPECTED PASSENGER VESSELS (OUPV)

Also known as a Charter Boat License, allows you to captain a vessel with up to six (6) paying passengers.

SEA SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Near Coastal 360 days of service, **of which** 90 days of service on Ocean, Near Coastal, or Great lakes waters

Great Lakes 360 days of service, **of which** 90 days of service on Great Lakes

Inland 360 days of service

Recency 90 Days in the past 3 years on vessels

Minimum Age Requirement: 18

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed USCG Application including sea-time documentation
- USCG Physical Examination
- USCG Drug Test
- Transportation Workers Identification Card (TWIC)
