



LAUNCH OPERATOR

The Launch Operator license allows a person to run a launch at a yacht club or marina. The age requirement depends upon the number of passengers the launch carries.

SEA SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

<u>LICENSE</u>	<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>AGE</u>	<u>SEA SERVICE</u>
Limited OUPV	Operate uninspected passenger vessel/ launch (OUPV) carrying no more than six (6) passengers in a limited geographic area	17 Years of Age	90 days (4+ hours/ day) of documented sea service 90 days in the last 3 years
Limited Masters	Operate inspected passenger vessels/ launch (OUPV) carrying seven (7) passengers or more in a limited geographic area	18 Years of Age	120 days (4+ hours/ day) of documented sea service 90 days in the last three years

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed USCG Application including sea-time documentation
- USCG Physical Examination
- USCG Drug Test
- Transportation Workers Identification Card (TWIC)

TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

- Launch Tender/Operator 16 hours
- First Aid / CPR 8 hours
